Englewood Community Development Corporation receives \$375K for Black congregations

In addition to IAAQLI funding, Indiana University Health awards \$375,000 to support Black churches on the south side of Indianapolis, funding projects like food pantries, recovery programs, and job training. This grant is part of a \$6.1 million community investment.


