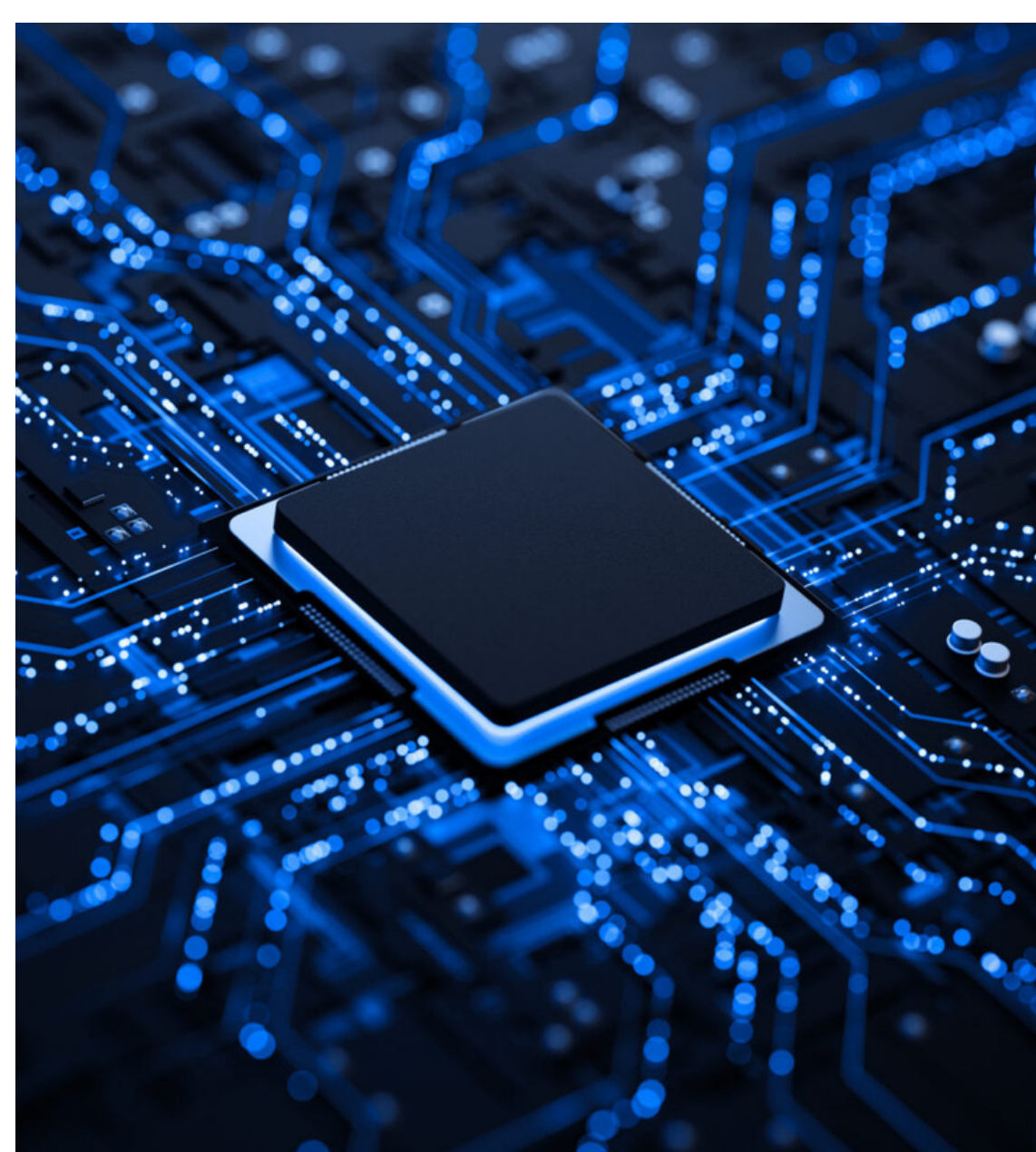
Pillar 3: Employment

TechIndiana and InnoPower Indy Launch Pre-Apprenticeship Pipeline into Indiana's Technology Talent Pathway

TechIndiana and InnoPower Indy are partnering to embed entrepreneurship and AI-literacy training from the "High School to the Pros" program into Marion County career centers, feeding students into TechIndiana's tech apprenticeship pipeline (INCAP). The initiative aims to grow from about 245 students in Year 1 to 425+ across 10 sites by 2027–2028. Stories like this from the Indianapolis Recorder are made possible by IAAQLI.

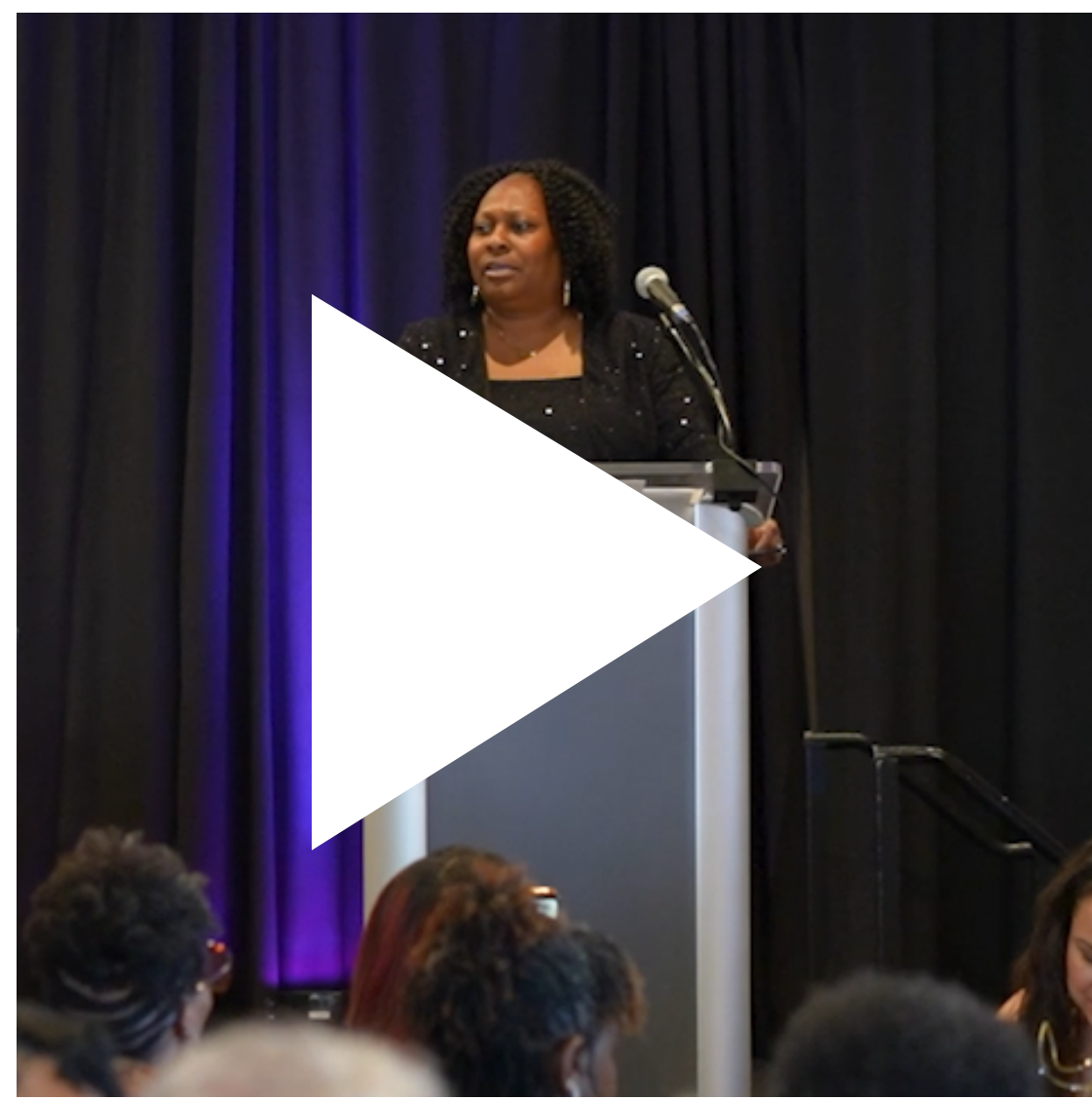
